ACADEMIC WEIGHTING OF GRADES

The District wishes to reward students for exemplary academic achievement. Therefore, students enrolled in courses beyond Regents level (District approved college courses through a District program or through a BOCES program or students enrolled in Advanced Placement Courses) will have their grade weighted at a weighting factor of 1.10 of the actual grade earned. All other courses will have a weighting factor as follows:

Regents and all inclusive courses - 1.05 Non-Regents academic courses - 1.00 Vocational / Occupational Courses - 1.00

The weighted grade will be computed by the teacher and entered on the report card. There will be a note placed in the "comments" section of the report card indicating that the grade is a weighted grade. Weighted grades will be used to compute honor rolls, Honor Society status, and class rank.
