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EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES - PARENTAL CONSENT POLICY

It is the policy of the Board of Education to require any student wishing to participate in an extracurricular activity or a club to obtain written parental permission prior to participation in the Club or activity. If the student wishes to participate in more than one extracurricular club or activity, a permission slip will be needed for each extracurricular activity or club the student wishes to participate in.

The term parent shall mean person in a parental relationship to the student.

Students over the age of 18 will not need written parental consent to participate in extracurricular activities.

It shall be the responsibility of each extracurricular activity or club advisor to ensure that students in the activity or club have obtained the necessary written parental consent.

Further, the Board of Education directs the Superintendent's office to develop a parental consent form to be used in accordance with this policy.
