Proposition #2

Shall the Board of Education establish a capital reserve fund under the provisions of Education Law § 3651 (1)? The purpose of the fund is for construction, repair, and reconstruction of capital improvements and the acquisition of equipment. The ultimate amount of the fund shall be \$4,000,000. The probable term shall be 20 years. The source from which funds will be obtained can include any or all of the following: \$1,000,000 authorized to be transferred from the current Capital Reserve Fund, unappropriated fund balances from the general fund as determined by the Board of Education from time to time, State aid related to expenditures from the capital reserve fund, interest income related to investment of monies in the fund, and any other additional monies thereafter authorized by the voters of the District, and any other legal source of funding.
