




Project At A Glance: Paved Parking Lot






Project At A Glance: STEM Classroom

Project Cost & Funding

Project funds will come from the following areas:

SMART SCHOOL BOND ACT	\$475,000
CAPITAL WORK BOND	\$9,079,323
TOTAL COST OF PROJECT	\$9,554,323
PERCENTAGE PAID BY STATE	77.5%

The total cost of this project is \$9,554,323 of which **77.5**% will be paid for by the state. For a homeowner in the Charlotte Valley Central School District with a residence valued at \$100,000 with Regular STAR, the estimated impact of changes to the district debt service is no more than \$5.33 per month.



What's Different & Why Now?

- Changes made specifically based on the feedback received from the first vote
- □ Lowering the total cost of the project by nearly \$6,000,000
- □ Designing a project that <u>does not include any extravagances</u>.
- □ Project work has been prioritized based on a recently completed Building Condition Survey (BCS). The BCS identified long-term building infrastructure upgrades such as roof and asphalt replacement as well as instruction driven projects such as a BOCES renovation to a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) learning space and Pre-K classroom space renovations.
