<u>Section</u> <u>3.</u> The Vice President of the Board of Education or the District Clerk may execute such notes in place of the Board President if the Board President shall so designate.

<u>Section</u> <u>4.</u> It is hereby determined and declared that it is the intent of this Board of Education that this resolution remain in full force and effect in perpetuity for the issuance of the aforesaid notes from year to year, until this resolution is modified, amended, rescinded, revoked or repealed by the Board.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
