Recind of previous motion regarding cell phones

On a motion by B. Garrison and seconded by M. Moyse, the following verbage was approved regarding the possession of cell phones by students in school: 2) Use Possession of cell phones is prohibited during the school day for all students Pre-K - 8. If a student is found to be in use possession of a communication device the following consequences will occur:

Changes to language regarding cell phones in Student Code of Conduct

3) For students in grades 9-12 ~~use possession~~ of cell phones is only permitted at lunch, during activity period, in hallways between classes and ~~the last 10 minutes of~~ during study hall at the study hall monitors discretion.
