- All fundraising/events must be put on the school calendar. This is to prevent overlapping events.
- Any poster that is going up must have prior approval by the faculty advisors.
- Signs must be taken down the day after the event.
- Violation of any rules could cause funds in the account to be frozen and repetitive violations could cause revoking of the chapter.
- This is an annual requirement.
- This form must be returned by **September 22** to be approved by the Board of Education.
