1) Purpose

- To provide members of the senior class with the opportunity for increased freedom.
- To entrust the members of the senior class with increased responsibility.
- To reward the senior class members for their positive impact at Charlotte Valley, not only with their intelligence, but their character as well.

2) Privileges

- Being a senior is a right but privileges are not. We think that there are certain standards that need to be followed in order to obtain these privileges.
- Privileges should be treated like sports.(People on the deficiency list or people who cannot follow the rules should not have privileges granted to them.)
- Seniors may come to school late if they have a study hall first period.
- Seniors may walk to the Quickway for lunch any day of the week as long as they sign out at the office. Students may not drive.
- Seniors may eat outside on the picnic tables.
- Seniors are allowed to go to a designated area or a senior lounge after letting the study hall teacher know where they are going (once one becomes available.)
- Seniors may use their phones for the whole period of a study hall if they are unable to sign out to a senior lounge.

3) Requirements of Students

- All students who partake in the aforementioned privileges must be a member of the
 graduating senior class, must be passing all their classes, and must be free and clear of all
 disciplinary issues. Any student who does not meet these requirements will lose their right
 to Senior Privileges.
- All students must sign, and have their parent/guardian sign, a senior privilege consent form in order to partake in the senior privileges listed above.
- In order to leave school grounds, the senior must sign out with the main office and must have permission from the parent/guardian.
